Background

- Established in 2003 (then as PRODWAT)
- Focus evolved over time towards MUS
- Mission: to be a platform of organizations, fulfilling resource centre functions, with the aim of improving delivery of multiple-use water services at different levels of scale, so as to better support poverty reduction





- 15 core member organizations
- Some 350 individual members on the mailing list
- Coordinator and secretary
- 2 meetings per year, sometimes linked to events, such as WWF, SWWW or symposium
- Phone conferences with core members
